

PSED/ Citizenship /

Our SEAL topics will be 'Going for Goals Good to be me'. We will continue to be Bucket Fillers and to focus on the Staveley values, which are Resilience, Compassion, Friendship and Respect. We will recycle within our classroom and learn how to look after our school outdoor environment.

Literacy

Daily phonics sessions will take place every day for all children. Spelling common exception words and writing sentences using capital letter, finger spaces and full stops and beginning to use exclamation marks and question marks in our writing. We will continue to practise our cursive letter formation and the correct orientation of letters and numbers.

Non-fiction - We will learn how to write a simple apology letter from Goldilocks to the three bears. We will create wanted posters for the 'Big, bad wolf' and write character descriptions for different fairy tale characters.

Fiction - We will write recounts of fairy tale stories and stories by Beatrix Potter. We will sequence stories. We will read and write our own stories about superheroes.

Poetry - We will write poems about Spring/ Easter using our senses and begin to use adjectives.

Reading - Children will have many opportunities to listen to a range of genres with a focus on fairy tales and stories about super heroes. We will continue to listen to the children read individually, working on fluency, expression and applying phonic knowledge. We will also be working on verbal comprehension skills.

Mathematics

We shall be studying place value to 50 and ordering numbers alongside practicing our addition and subtraction. We will solve missing number, true and false and spot the mistake problems to help develop reasoning and problem solving. We will count in 2's, 5's and 10's. We shall be measuring (length, capacity, time, money) We will measure blankets for baby bear's bed and the height of our beanstalk using standard measure (cm)

Science

We will identify different plants and trees and grow beans linked to our reading of 'Jack and the beanstalk.' We will make simple predictions about what we think will happen and what plants need to grow. We will look at seasonal changes and complete a class weather record throughout the school year.

Computing

We shall recognise common uses of information technology and begin to create and manipulate digital content. We will begin to learn to use the internet safely. We will programme beebots, using position and direction. We will play games to help support our learning in Maths and Phonics.

Muddy Mondays

Our Muddy Monday sessions will mainly link with our Science, Art and the world around us. We will look at seasonal changes and the weather. We will begin to grow vegetables in our class raised bed. We will plant wildflower seeds.

History

We will find out about different types of houses and order the age of a building on a simple timeline. We will find out about Beatrix Potter and visit Hill top farm. We will compare how she lived to how we live now.

Geography

We will locate the Lake District national park on a map of the UK. We will look at aerial maps and begin to identify lakes, mountains and forests. We will learn about simple maps.

Art and Design

We will create art work of fairy tale settings using watercolour paint, collage and oil pastels. We will draw flowers using pencil and watercolour and design polystyrene tiles to create a border for our art work, exploring printing techniques.

Design and Technology

We will design and make our own fairy tale character split pin puppets.
