On the Local Habitat Survey Activity Sheet, you drew a sketch map of the habitat, drawing and labelling any environmental dangers that you saw there.</p> <p>How can you have a positive effect on the local habitat? Complete the 'Helping the Local Habitat Activity Sheet' to draw one idea you have for helping the local habitat, and write a brief explanation of how it will help protect the local living things.</p> <p>Computing: can you make a PowerPoint to persuade people they need to make positive changes to our local area? Maybe you took photos which you could insert?</p>	<p>History: Ancient Greek Gods</p> <p>Read the information about Greek gods. Cut and stick the pictures and statements about the different gods and match them together.</p> <p>Next week we will be planning and writing some myths involving Greek Gods.</p> <p>Art/DT:</p> <p>Can you paint one of the Greek Gods with symbols relating to them around the edge? Can you use the recycling to create the Pantheon?</p> <p>Music: Year 4's English work is all about Peter and the Wolf this week. It is one of my favourite pieces of music!
