Can you sort the animal cards?</p> <p>Complete the 'Vertebrates Activity Sheet' and then complete the 'Key Questions Activity sheet' by thinking about yes or no questions.</p> <p>Play 20 questions with your family – choose an animal and then your family members can only ask you yes or no questions to guess your animal</p> | <p>History: Ancient Greek Democracy Find out what the word 'democracy' means. Research the difference between Ancient Greek democracy and UK democracy today – you could fill in the table to show what you have learnt or use the pre prepared statements.</p> <p>You could do some persuasive writing to persuade me that 10 year olds should or shouldn't have the vote. Can you remember using counter arguments and persuasive language? Don't forget an introduction and a conclusion.</p> <p>Art: Choose an animal you love and draw, paint or sculpt it. I would love to see photos of any that you complete.</p> <p>Music: Keep learning the songs and dances for the Virtual Big Sing</p> <p>Food technology: Can you make a Greek salad or another Greek food for your family?
