

## PSED

Our SEAL topics will be 'Going for goals' and 'Good to be me'. We will continue to be Bucket Fillers and to focus on the Staveley values, which are Resilience, Compassion, Friendship and Respect. We will also learn about the importance of recycling.

## Literacy

Daily phonics sessions will take place every day for all children. Spelling common exception words and writing sentences using capital letter, finger spaces and full stops will be incorporated into all writing. The children will be learning how to use question marks, exclamation marks and extending their sentences using the conjunction 'and'. We will practise our letter formation and begin to use the 'Journey to cursive un-looped font' to help prepare us for joining our handwriting.

Non-fiction – we will write instructions, recipes and recounts.

Fiction – We will be reading stories about witches and spells. Writing our own potions using adjectives and number words.

Reading - Children will have lots of opportunities to listen to a range of genres. We will continue to listen to the children read individually, working on fluency, expression and comprehension skills.

## Mathematics

We shall be studying addition and subtraction within 20, place value within 50 and measurement. We will solve word problems and count in 2's, 5's and 10's.

## Science

We will continue to identify and sort everyday material and look at change of state. We will look at seasonal changes, weather and identifying plants and trees.

## Computing

We will play games to help support our learning in Maths and Phonics. We will use programmable robots to help us follow instructions. We will continue to learn about staying safe online.

## Physical Education

We shall be practicing our basic movements, agility, balance and coordination. We will learn how to work well as part of a team.

## Music

We shall be following the 'Charanga' programme. This will include understanding pitch, playing percussion instrument and learning and performing songs.

## Muddy Mondays

Our Muddy Monday sessions will mainly link with our Science, Art and the world around us. We will look at seasonal changes and weather. We will be making mud to explore mixing. We will be planting, growing and identifying different plants and trees throughout the spring term.

## History

We will find out about Florence Nightingale and how she helped change the NHS. We will begin to look at timelines.

## Geography

We will be looking at maps of Staveley and places of interest in our village. We will learn how to use and make a basic symbol map. We will begin to look at the difference between human and physical features in our local area.

## Art and Design

We will learn about colour mixing, naming primary colours and making a colour wheel. We will develop art and design techniques by making pattern pictures using lines and shapes. We will make our own print pictures by designing and making our own printing stamps.

## Design and Technology

We will be learning about health and nutrition. We shall be learning how to follow a recipe and measure ingredients. We will be making and tasting rocky road, pizzas, bread and vegetable soup.

## Homework

Please 'Strive for 5' reads every week and record all reading in reading logs. Spellings will be sent home on a Thursday to be learnt and returned for the following Thursday. Take any opportunity you can to count in 2's, 5's and 10's and practise the correct formation of numbers to 20.
