### Breakfast Club and After School Club

Many children come to our breakfast and/or after school club and so we just wanted to take this opportunity to remind parents it is available. If you need to book in please phone or e-mail the school office.

Breakfast Club runs every morning from 8.00 – 8.45 am. A full session, including breakfast, is £5. A half session 8.20 – 8.45am is £2.50.

After School Club runs every day 3.15 – 5.30pm except Friday which finishes at 4.30pm. A full session is £9 if booked with 24 hours' notice, if on the day £10. A half session 3.15 – 4.30pm is £6.

### Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Each Year the school receives extra funding from the government to provide additional support and educational experiences for children who come from lower income homes. This funding is called Pupil Premium and can help ensure all children have access to the same opportunities and activities. The funding is used in school in a variety of ways. Your child will receive a free school meal, it is used to support additional learning, to provide more interventions to accelerate your child's academic progress as well as interventions to develop self-esteem, self-confidence and social emotional skills. You can apply online at <https://www.cumbria.gov.uk/childrensservices/schoolsandlearning/freeschoolmeals.asp> You will receive an immediate response advising you whether you are eligible or not. If you are unable to apply online please contact the free school meals team – telephone 01228 606060.

The school can qualify for Pupil Premium for your child if you receive one of the following:

1. Income Support
2. Income based Job Seekers Allowance (IBJSA)
3. Income related Employment and Support Allowance
4. Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
5. Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
6. Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16190 and not in receipt of Working Tax credit
7. Working Tax Credit Run-On (the payment you receive for further weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
8. Universal Credit

At the moment children in KS1 are in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, this is something totally different. If you think you are eligible for Free School Meals and therefore, Pupil Premium then you still need to apply. Please contact the School Office if you need any further clarification.
